Epson Projector Filter Cleaning

Teachers,

If you have a projector in your room you will need to clean out the filter about once a six weeks or it may overheat and give you an error message.

Overheating of the projectors is caused by two conditions.

- 1. The room is very hot. The projectors create a lot of heat. They have no way of cooling except by blowing air across the bulb. When the room is hot, the air around the projector is even hotter and will not cool the projector.
- 2. The filter that keeps dust out of the projector becomes packed. This reduces the amount of air that passes through the projector.

Two Solutions:


- 1. Turn off the projector when you are not using it. Rule: 5 minutes. Not only will this keep the projector and room cooler, it will prolong the life of the bulb.
- 2. <u>Clean the filter on your projector</u> once six weeks.

Locate the small **black filter** just below the lens.

Pull it straight out.







Take it to the trash can and blow out the dust into the trash can.

Note: You may have to shake the filter or tap it against the side of the trash can if there is a lot of dust.
